



Environmental Education Internships

Three environmental education internships are available in the Education Department at Cincinnati Nature Center's Rowe Woods site in Milford, OH. As an Environmental Education Intern, individuals will become a valued, integral part of the staff as they teach students from preschool through high school about ecology and the environment, assist with the planning and implementation of tours and programs for the general public, special events, and curriculum development, and contribute to the overall operation of the nature center.

General Duties

- Teach school groups, assist with teaching in early childhood programs.
- Assist with the development and delivery of programs for a variety of member and non-member audiences of all ages on weekdays, weekends, and evenings.
- Assist with curriculum development, evaluation, and revision.
- Assist with the development of teaching tools, crafts, and other education materials.
- Assist with the training of CNC volunteer educators.
- Serve on CNC Education Team.
- Other opportunities based on the interests and abilities of the intern.

Requirements

- At least three years of college required; baccalaureate degree preferred.
- A passion for teaching and the natural world.
- Ability to teach a variety of ages.
- Proficient in public speaking.
- Good writing and oral communication skills; good customer service skills.
- Experience in teaching, coaching, summer camp, etc. preferred.
- General familiarity with the natural environment/agriculture is a plus.

Application Process

This is a full-time intern position requiring 40 hours per week, including some weekends. Interns are required to complete a Learning Contract and undergo periodic evaluations, as well as commit to the entire length of the term (start and end dates are flexible.)

Early application is encouraged.
