

SUMMER OPPORTUNITIES — 2012

Spend your summer outdoors! Earn money doing something you enjoy! Help to make the world a better place! Join the Cincinnati Nature Center's day camp staff this summer.

WHERE: One of Cincinnati Nature Center's two sites: Rowe Woods or Long Branch, both located less than 20 miles from downtown Cincinnati.

THE JOB: Guide children in environmental learning activities and projects, hikes, songs, stories, games, and crafts as they actively explore the world around us. Campers learn about their environment by experiencing it, enjoying it, and learning to care for it.

REQUIREMENTS: A hearty interest in the outdoors and enthusiasm for sharing that interest with children. Some knowledge and training in natural science. Experience working with children. Applicants should be 18 years or older.

COMMITMENT: Early June - early August, typically 8 a.m.-3 p.m. weekdays with some longer hours on certain weeks. A week of training takes place in early June.

REWARDS: Summer staff work with professional educators, enjoy rich learning experiences, and gain a variety of teaching techniques and ideas. Credit may be available through a college or university. In addition to guiding daily activities, camp staff helps prepare materials and contribute their own creative ideas to the program. Salary is commensurate with experience and starts at \$7.50 - 8.00/hr., depending on experience. Voluntary positions are also available.
